July 17 & 18: Raku picnic & kiln-building workshop with Andy Schuster

Saturday & Sunday: 10 am - 4 pm

Guild meeting & Raku picnic on Sunday at around 1 pm

Location: Stone Quarry Hill Art Park, 3883 Stone Quarry Road, Cazenovia, NY

Join us at the Art Park on July 17 & 18 for a weekend kiln-building workshop with ceramist Andy Schuster. This will be a hands-on workshop in which Andy will lead the construction of a small wood-fired Raku kiln to replace the previous gas Raku kiln. The focus will be on hands-on construction experience and discussion of kiln design. We will complete most of the building of the kiln on Saturday and then fire it on Sunday afternoon during the picnic.

Please bring a pair of work gloves, plenty of drinking water, and a bag lunch on Saturday.

If you plan on attending on Sunday, please bring a dish to pass for the picnic, something to drink, and your own eating utensils.

OPTIONAL: If you wish to participate in the firing on Sunday, bring a few small bisque-fired pots (roughly 6" x 6" or less).

Directions to the Art Park from the village of Cazenovia:

Travel east out of the village on US Route 20 for about 1 mile. Turn right on Stone Quarry Road. The Art Park entrance is just past the top of the hill on Stone Quarry Rd., about 1/2 mile from Route 20. Park office phone number: 315-655-3196
